Numbers 11:25

And the Yahweh came down in a cloud, and spake unto him, and took of the spirit that was upon him, and gave it unto the seventy elders: and it came to pass, that, when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied, and did not cease.

After reading Numbers 11 it makes sense to me this would have been about 50 days after passover and you have some amazing similarities to Acts 2.

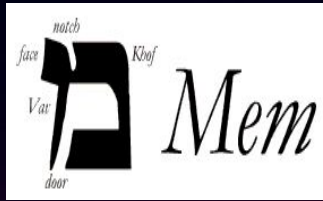

70 represents 70 nations, the Mixed Multitude.

Shin - Press, (Completeness - not complete without being pressed), (7)

Beyt - Family, House, (Congregation will be a mixed multitude)

Ayin - Watch, Know, (The multitude will be watching and all will know Him)

Yud - Worship, (The multitude will Worship)

Mem - Blood, (The blood paid for the multitude)

Acts 2:1-13 Names of God Bible (NOG)

2 When Pentecost, the fiftieth day after Passover, came, all the believers were together in one place. ² Suddenly, a sound like a violently blowing wind came from the sky and filled the whole house where they were staying.

³ Tongues that looked like fire appeared to them. The tongues arranged themselves so that one came to rest on each believer. ⁴ All the believers were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages as the Spirit gave them the ability to speak.



Genesis 10 list descendents of Noah. In Genesis 11 we read about the Tower of Babel.

The common understanding is that the people are scattered into 70 nations 70 languages of the Mixed Multitude.

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Acts 2:1-13 Names of God Bible (NOG)

⁵ Devout Jewish men from every nation were living in Jerusalem. ⁶ They gathered when they heard the wind. Each person was startled to recognize his own dialect when the disciples spoke.

⁷ Stunned and amazed, the people in the crowd said, “All of these men who are speaking are Galileans. ⁸ Why do we hear them speaking in our native dialects? ⁹ We’re Parthians, Medes, and Elamites.

Acts 2:1-13 Names of God Bible (NOG)

We're people from Mesopotamia, Judea, Cappadocia, Pontus, the province of Asia, ¹⁰ Phrygia, Pamphylia, Egypt, and the country near Cyrene in Libya. We're Jewish people, converts to Judaism, and visitors from Rome, ¹¹ Crete, and Arabia. We hear these men in our own languages

as they tell about the miracles that God has done.”

¹² All of these devout men were stunned and puzzled. They asked each other, “What can this mean?” ¹³ Others said jokingly, “They’re drunk on sweet wine.”

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The Book of Jubilees Noah

6:17 For this reason it has been ordained and written on the heavenly tablets that they should celebrate the *festival of weeks* during this month—once a year—to *renew the covenant each and every year.*



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The Book of Jubilees Abraham

44:1 Israel set out from *Hebron*, from his house, on the first of the third month. He went by way of the well of the oath and offered a sacrifice to the God of his father Isaac on the seventh of this month. 44:2 When Jacob remembered the dream that he had seen in Bethel, he was afraid to go down to Egypt.



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The Book of Jubilees Abraham

44:3 But as he was thinking about sending word to Joseph that he should come to him and that he would not go down, he remained there for seven days on the chance that he would see a vision (about) whether he should remain or go down.

44:4 He celebrated the harvest festival—the firstfruits of grain—with old grain because in all the land of Canaan there was not even a handful of seed in the land since the famine affected all the animals, the cattle, the birds, and mankind as well. 44:5 On the sixteenth the Lord appeared to him and said to him: ‘Jacob, Jacob’ ...

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The Book of Jubilees Abraham

Jubilees dates additional events to the 15th of the 3rd month:

1. 14:10 – covenant between the pieces (ברית בין הבתרים)
- b. 16:13 – birth of Isaac (fulfillment of promise in chapter 15)
- c. 29:7 – covenant with Laban

SAMSON

19 So Manoah took a young goat and a grain offering and sacrificed them to *Yahweh* on a rock he used as an altar. While Manoah and his wife watched, the Lord did something miraculous. 20 As the flame went up toward heaven from the altar,

the Messenger of *Yahweh* went up in the flame. When Manoah and his wife saw this, they immediately bowed down with their faces touching the ground.

21 The Messenger of *Yahweh* didn't appear again to Manoah and his wife. Then Manoah knew that this had been the Messenger of *Yahweh*. 22 So Manoah said to his wife, "We will certainly die because we have seen *Elohim*."
