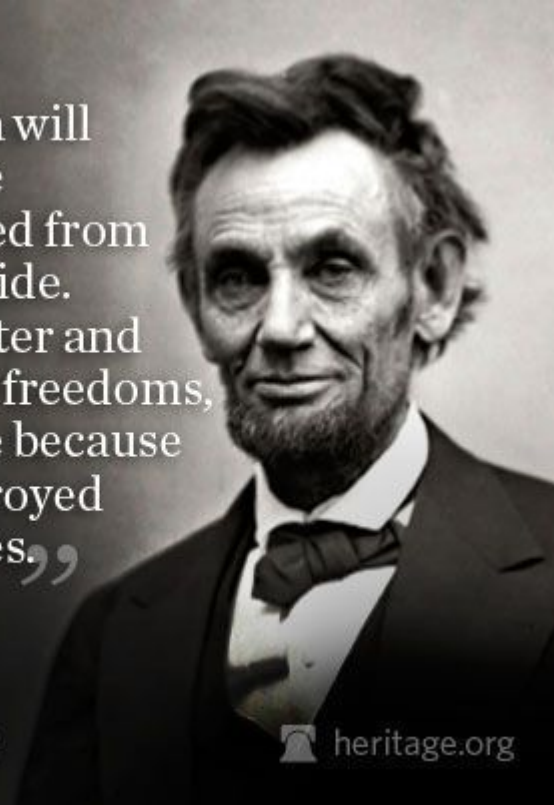





Credit to Steve Deace from "A Nefarious Plot"

1. You shall have no other Elohim before Yahweh.
  - a. Every state constitution mentions and thanks Elohim for its existence, freedom, or both.
  
2. You shall not make any graven images.
  - a. The state is not god. Only Yahweh is. Therefore, the state cannot establish a religion, nor restrict it.
  
3. You shall not take the name of Yahweh in vain.
  - a. The name of Elohim is so sacred, you make every elected official swear an oath of integrity and loyalty "so help me God." A reminder that by betraying your promise to your countrymen, you're really betraying Yahweh.

  - a. Days of remembrance are protected and made accessible by law.

6. You shall not murder.
  - a. The “unalienable” right to life mentioned in the Declaration of Independence.

# 10 Commandments Honored

**7. You shall not commit adultery.**

a. The civil law so revered the sacrament of marriage that it originally criminalized marriage behavior outside of the marriage covenant.

**8. You shall not steal.**

a. Private property rights were protected by law.

**9. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.**

a. Perjury is a crime. We impeached a president for it. Also, deceit was grounds for the breaking of contracts, which were treated like civic covenants in natural law, and therefore only allowed to be breached in extreme circumstances. Lying, false witness, and deceit were considered extreme circumstances back then.

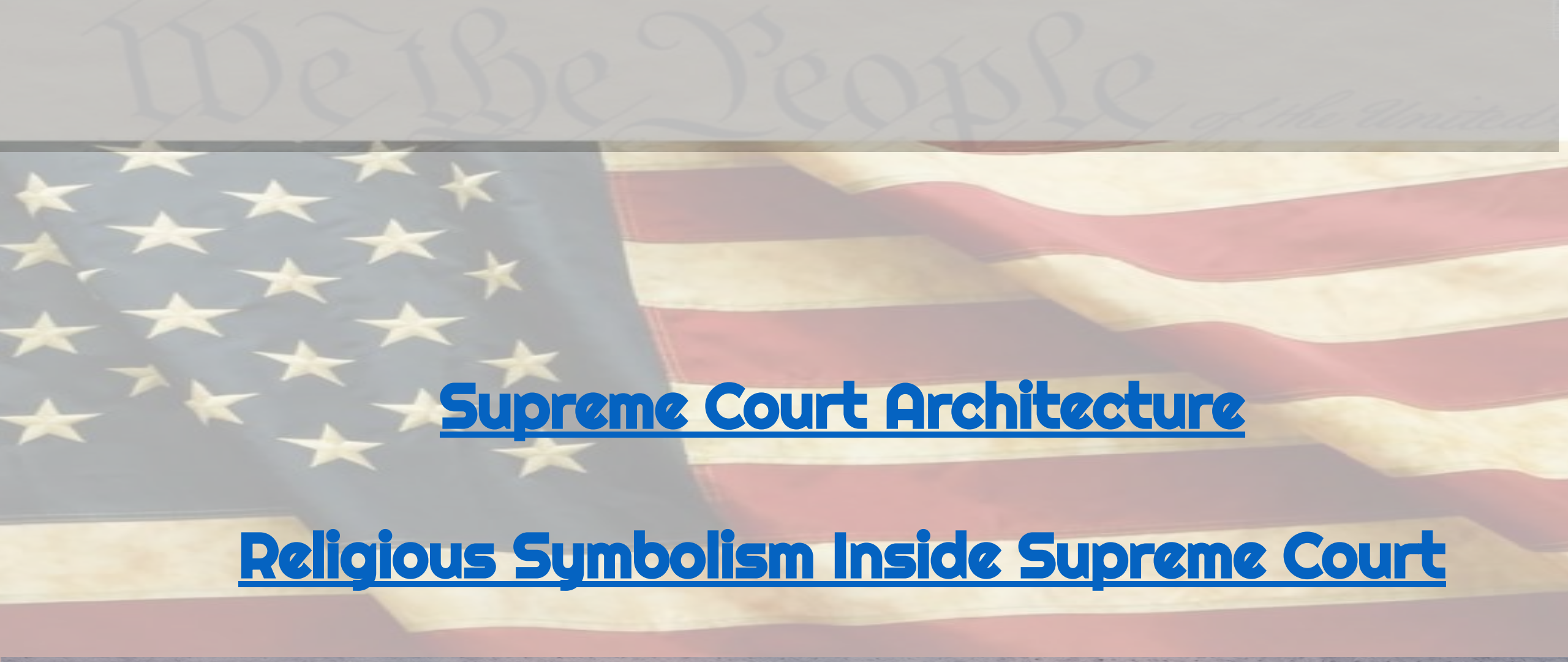

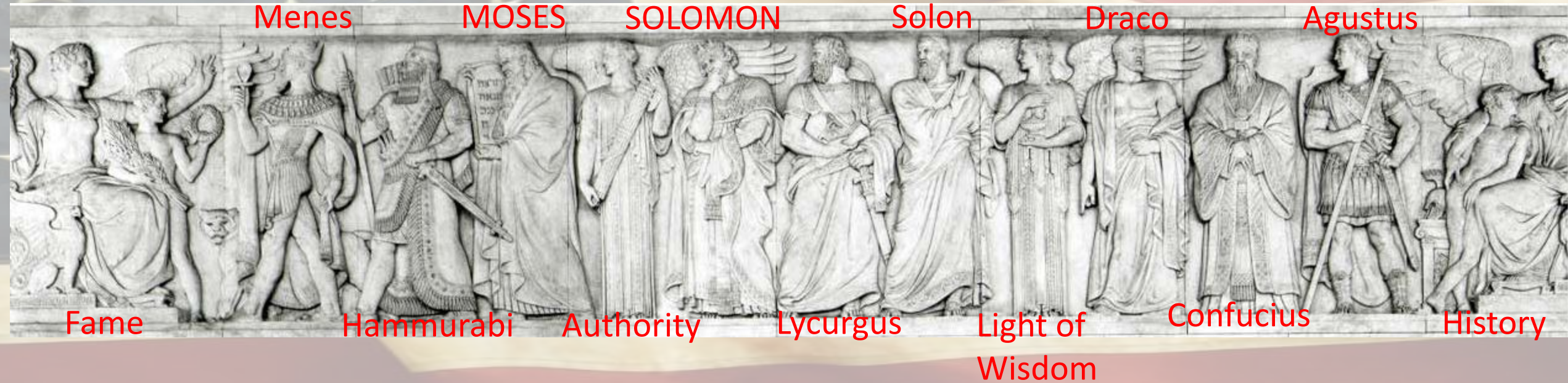
