Repentance


re·pent | \ ri-'pent \ repented; repenting; repents Definition of repent (Entry 1 of 2) intransitive verb






Galatians 2

21 I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.





Luke 23:39-43 Thief on the cross repents and is rewarded.





Jeremiah 8:5-6 King James Uersion 5 Why then is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? they hold fast deceit, they refuse to return.

6 I hearkened and heard, but they spake not aright: no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle.
