








Romans 13:1-7


I Let every soul be subject unto the governing authorities. For there is no authority but of Elohim: the authorities that be are ordained of Elohim. 2 Whosoever therefore resists the authority, resists the ordinance of Elohim: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation. 3 For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Will you then not be afraid of the authority? Do that which is good, and you shall have praise from the same: 4 For he is the minister of Elohim to you for good. But if you do that which is evil, be afraid; for he bears not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of Elohim, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that does evil.





5 Wherefore you need to be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake. 6 For this cause you pay taxes also: for they are Elohim's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing. 7 Render therefore to all their dues: taxes to whom taxes are due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

When the government tells a "church"/assembly of Yah it has to close its doors but the liquor store can remain open because it is "essential" do you forsake the gathering together?





I Samuel 8:10-14 (NOG)

10 Then Samuel told the people who had asked him for a king everything Yahweh had said. 11 Samuel said, "These are the rights of a king: He will draft your sons, make them serve on his chariots and horses, and make them run ahead of his chariots. 12 He will appoint them to be his officers over 1,000 or over 50 soldiers, to plow his ground and harvest his crops, and to make weapons and equipment for his chariots. 13 He will take your daughters and have them make perfumes, cook, and bake. 14 He will take the best of your fields, vineyards, and olive orchards and give them to his officials.





I Samuel 8:14-18 (NOG)

15 He will take a tenth of your grain and wine and give it to his aids and officials. 16 He will take your male and female slaves, your best cattle,[a] and your donkeys for his own use. 17 He will take a tenth of your flocks. In addition, you will be his servants. 18 "When that day comes, you will cry out because of the king whom you have chosen for yourselves. Yahweh will not answer you when that day comes." the scripture saith, Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treads out the grain. 

15 Then the king of Egypt told the Hebrew midwives, whose names were Shiphrah and Puah, 16 "When you help the Hebrew women in childbirth, look at the child when you deliver it. If it's a boy, kill it, but if it's a girl, let it live." 17 However, the midwives feared Elohim and didn't obey the king of Egypt's orders. They let the boys live. 18 So the king of Egypt called for the midwives. He asked them, "Why have you done this? Why have you let the boys live?" 19 The midwives answered Pharaoh, "Hebrew women are not like Egyptian women. They are so healthy that they have their babies before a midwife arrives." 20 Elohim was good to the midwives. So the people increased in number and became very strong. 21 Because the midwives feared Elohim, he gave them families of their own.








Additionally, Paul was arrested about 6 times in all. Felix had him imprisoned for about 2 years in Ceasarea.






The historical understanding of Paul's death is that he died for his faith at the hands of Nero.

Wouldn't the fact that Paul was martyred imply that he defied Nero in some manner?
















Those Who Govern
